
On average, how often do you or your family visit the Watkins Glen Public Library? 209 responses










The Watkins Glen Public Library is important to the local community. 210 responses












How do you find out about library programs and events? Check all that apply. 203 responses




How satisfied are you with the overall physical condition of the library?




How satisfied are you with the library's...








How satisfied are you with the library's...




How important are the following library services to you?






If the library offered the following services, how likely would you be to use them?




Do you live in the Watkins Glen Central School District? 208 responses




What is your age group?
